


Access to Kyoto



1. Kyoto is in the Kansai region (west area) of Japan. Kansai International Airport is the closest International airport and it takes 75 minutes.

2. Osaka International Airport (Itami Airport) handles domestic flights and is about 1 hour from Kyoto by train. People often fly into this airport by connecting through Tokyo Haneda or Tokyo Narita airport.

3. Those visiting other parts of Japan my wish to use the bullet train (shinkansen). The bullet train is a smooth 2-hour ride from Tokyo to Kyoto.
