

Nankai Railways is one of popular lines in Kansai regions, especially known for The Nankai <u>Airport Express</u> and the <u>Limited Express Rapi:t</u>, that connect KIX with *Namba* Station, which is an important

transportation hub in the "Minami" district of Osaka.

- Duration to *Namba* by Nankai Airport Express: <u>44 minutes</u> Fare: 920 yen for adult

 By Limited Express *Rapi:t*: <u>34-37 minutes</u> Fare: app. 1,450 yen for adult

Airport Express runs from 05:45 to 23:55 in almost every 20 minutes from KIX.

- Only app. 4 stops at Tennouji- Shinosaka-Takatsuki- Kyoto (tentative)
- The train has first-class, reserved and non-reserved seating, with toilet, luggage racks etc.
- Operated in every 30 minutes.


To Kyoto Station by Limousine Bus

Limousine Bus is another option for your transfer to Kyoto, Osaka, or other cities in Kansai regions. After your arrival, please go to $\underline{\text{the } 1^{\text{st}} \text{ floor.}}$



The bus terminal and Taxi stands are just outside of Immigration arrival on $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ floor. There are Limousine Bus ticket vending machines and information desk.



- Duration: to Kyoto app. 90 minutes Fare: app. 2,500-2,600 yen for adult to Osaka app. 60 minutes Fare: 1600 yen for adult
 - *Please note that fare rates may vary depends on bus route to destination.
- Child fare is a half price.






Kyoto Tourist Information Center (as the photo above right)

Taxi Ranks at Kyoto station




There are <u>two taxi ranks</u> at Kyoto Station on the north and south side of the building. It is easy to hail a taxi on the street too.

- Taxi Fares differ according to the size of the taxi. Tip to Taxi drivers is unnecessary in Japan.
- Please tell your destination to Taxi driver, and if necessary, show the driver map or address indicating your destination.
- Please check the taxi mater for your payment upon arrival. (See the photo above right)

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IN KYOTO

Public transport in Kyoto is well organized.

Many trains run through the city, such as the <u>Kyoto City Subway</u>, JR line, Hankyu Railway and <u>Keihan Railway</u>.



The Kyoto City Subway is composed of 2 lines: Karasuma Line runs north-south, and the Tozai Line runs east-west.

Nearest station to <u>ICC Kyoto</u> (the conference venue) is *Kokusaikaikan* on the <u>Karasuma Line</u>. (Please see the map above.)
